## Required Minimum Qualifications Fats, Oils & Grease Management II Program Development / Management Training

The Florida Industrial Pretreatment Association (FIPA) conducts training courses and exams for voluntary certifications in Industrial Pretreatment and Fats, Oils & Grease Program Management. Courses are open to industrial pretreatment professionals, laboratory personnel, and water/wastewater operators. By completing a 2-day course, an individual may earn 1.6 Continuing Education Units (CEUs) issued through accredited organizations.

Required minimum qualifications for FOG II Management (Program Development/Management Training) Exam & Voluntary Certification:

- 1. Must have accumulated 1 year of experience in grease trap or oil/water separator device management, grease trap or oil/water separator device inspection, grease prevention program code enforcement, industrial pretreatment, wastewater collection or treatment, water/reclaimed water distribution or treatment, and/or laboratory sampling or analysis. This course strives to help develop or enhance a FOG Program.
- 2. Must successfully complete the FOG II Management course through FIPA.
- 3. Must achieve a grade of 70% or greater on the FOG II course certification exam.
