Required Minimum Qualifications Wastewater Sampling for Industrial Pretreatment

The Florida Industrial Pretreatment Association (FIPA) conducts training courses and exams for voluntary certifications in Industrial Pretreatment and Fats, Oils & Grease Program Management. Courses are open to industrial pretreatment professionals, laboratory personnel, and water/wastewater operators. By completing a 2-day course, an individual may earn 1.6 Continuing Education Units (CEUs) issued through accredited organizations.

Required minimum qualifications for Wastewater Sampling for Industrial Pretreatment:

1. Must have accumulated 6 months of experience in wastewater sample collection, field testing and/or laboratory sampling

This course does not include an exam; attendees will be issued a certificate of completion at the conclusion of the course.
